
# WHERE WE ARE




Fibbiano is located in the heart of the Pisan Hills, nestled between the Tyrrhenian Sea and the Era River.



#### **HISTORY**







### Our history dates back a long time.

Handwritten documents in the State Archives of Pisa reveal that as early as 1560, Fibbiano was recognized as a thriving farm where vines were cultivated. It was owned by Agostino di Francesco Artimini from Peccioli, who was a citizen of Pisa. Within our property, there are two Etruscan tombs, showcasing the ancient presence in the area. The Etruscans were already engaged in wine production during that time.



#### **TERROIR**









The history of the Pisan Hills goes back to distant geological eras when the continents underwent dramatic shifts, collisions, subsidence, and uplift, leading to the current landscape of the Monti Pisani being below sea level. During the Pliocene, sand rich in shells and mollusks accumulated on the seabed that once covered much of Tuscany.

These shells are now found in our vineyards and throughout the Pisan Hills, enriching our soils with minerals and fossil substances that impart a unique character to our wines.

We have always been committed to recovering abandoned or forgotten grape varieties that are part of the winemaking heritage of Pisa and Tuscany. These varieties represent the history, voice, and essence of the land.

To this end, with the assistance of university research groups, we analyzed our centuries-old vineyard "Ceppatella"; from which we selected the mother plants for all the existing vineyards on our estate:

- Colombana
- Vermentino

## IN FERMENTO



The vivacity of Vermentino shines in this naturally sparkling (Pet Nat) wine, exuding a joyful spirit. It is a wine that is meant to be enjoyed carefree.

### **VERMENTINO**



Nestled among the gentle slopes of the Pisan Hills, rich in shells and fossil corals, Vermentino thrives in the ideal conditions offered by the sea breeze. This grape variety has many facets, and its liveliness delights the palate, inviting you to take another sip.

#### COLOMBANA



The Colombana grape is named after the 6th-century Irish missionary monk, Columbanus. This variety was introduced to Tuscany in the 17th century by one of his followers. Known for both its exceptional quality and its healing properties, Colombana has been revived by the Cantoni family at Fibbiano in its first pure vinified version, four hundred years later.

#### FONTE DELLE DONNE



Within the estate's territory lies the Fonte delle Donne, a spring believed to have miraculous powers. It is said that the extraordinary water from this spring could restore milk to nursing mothers. This wine, made from Vermentino and Colombana grapes, is dedicated to the miraculous spring.
